

Dear Tamarack Waldorf School Community,

As things have quickly shifted we are changing the plans for picking up items from school. We ask that parents and guardians wait until Wednesday to pick up items from school.

Today teachers are working to put materials and curriculum together for 3 weeks of distance learning. Packets will be available for picked up on **Wednesday from 7am-3pm**. The distance learning curriculum is being planned to begin on Monday, March 23 unless otherwise indicated by your class teacher.

As the need for social distancing is required, we will only allow 5 people into the building at a time to collect their student's distance learning curriculum packets, gear from the basement, and musical instrument. We ask that students not be brought into the building.

- Access to the building will be limited to the front hall and basement.
- Classrooms will be off limits.
- Student work packets will be labeled by name and organized by grade in the front hallway.
- Musical instruments will be in the front hall or basement.

Parents and guardians will receive an email from their class teacher explaining that they will be using their school email to communicate with parents. Parent Square will be used for all school messaging only. We ask that you stay alert for messages from your class teacher and from the school.
